

Yorkshire Water have informed us that they will soon be starting work on installing a new sewer under the A65.

This work will run for about 12 months. They are creating a site on the field next to school and will be fencing off about a ½ of it (nearest to the A65). They will create an access entrance from the A65.

Impact on school and parking should be minimal and they will attempt to minimise movement to and from the site around school drop offs and pick ups.
