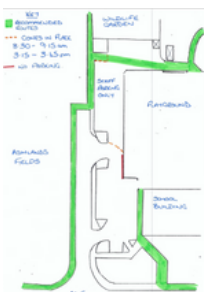
Parents must stay with children who are attending running club and are in reception, years 1 and 2
