

WOW

We have re-established the WOW initiative. WOW (walk once a week) is a pupil-led initiative, where children self-report how they get to school every day using the interactive WOW Travel Tracker. If they travel sustainably (walk, cycle, scoot or 'park and stride') at least once a week for a month, they get rewarded with a badge. Park and stride is parking a little further away from school and walking the extra bit or getting off at the bus stop before the one nearest school.

We also understand that this is not possible for all families so if you cant commit to this, your child can choose to walk, jog or run around the playground twice at break time and this can count towards their WOW.
