PE KIT DAYS

Please send your Child in their School PE kit on the following days.

(Please note that children should come to school in their PE kit on these days regardless of whether they tell you that they are doing PE, Forest Schools, Art or music).

Reception – Thursday. The children will alternate between PE & Outdoor Adventures so will need some wellies to keep in school as well.

Year 1 – 1 Willow – Monday & Wednesday and 1 Oak Wednesday & Thursday

Year 2 – Wednesdays – both classes (2 Cherry is doing Forest Schools on a Wednesday until October ½ term) and also Friday for 2 Beech & Monday for 2 Cherry.

Year 3 – Tuesday & Thursday

Year 4 – Thursdays & Fridays (4 Yew is doing Forest Schools until October ½ term)

Year 5 – Tuesdays

Year 6 – Tuesdays & Fridays (6 Birch is doing Forest Schools until October ½ term).
