Practise spelling the Year 1 Common Exception Words . You could play a phonics version of I-Spy (eg "I spy f-i-sh)	Practise addition skills by combing groups of toys or other objects and counting the total. Make groups of toys and then take some away - predict the amount remaining before counting to check. Identify 2-D shapes and 3-D shapes that you see around us, at home and outside.	Help your child to write a letter to a friend, a relative or a neighbour, describing a picture drawn for them. This can lead on to writing a letter to Father Christmas.	Encourage your child to read regularly at home. Support them with their reading by asking questions about what they have read. Facetime/Zoom a family member and let your child read them a favourite story. Visit your local library and read three new books by your favourite author.	Visit the Oxford Owl website and complete your weekly reading tasks. You will find your log in details inside your reading record. Use a fake keyboard to find the letters in familiar words (we will send a copy of this home)
