Here are a variety of OPTIONAL activities which you may wish to do with your child out of school to support and extend their learning in school.

We will continue to send home weekly spellings and Maths and encourage daily reading.

This term we are learning about Ancient Greece. Here are some ideas if you wish to carry out a mini-project on an aspect of Ancient Greek life: Cook some Greek food or a meal. Write up the recipes. Can you include a photo of your creation too?



Find out some simple Greek phrases. E.g Hello, How are you? What's your name? etc. Can you make a poster to display them in Greek and English? If you can learn the pronunciation, can you try and teach us at school?



Make a collage using pictures from holiday brochures or the internet showing ancient buildings and interesting place to visit in Greece.



Make a Spartan helmet or design a shield.

Design and make your own Labyrinth. It could be made of straws, string or wood.



Research an aspect of Ancient Greek life, for example houses, family life, food and/or clothing. You could present is as a poster, booklet or model.

Please remember the grid is optional but your child may be rewarded with house points for their efforts
