

One of Pippa's final wishes was for a festival to be held in her memory to raise money for Teenage Cancer Trust, who provided Pippa and her family with exceptional care and emotional support, and meant Pippa never had to go through her most difficult times alone.

Pippa's sister Lara and friend Cornell have put together a full day's programme of amazing musicians from midday till 11pm. There will be food outlets, a bar, various stalls, a raffle, and much more.

Teenage Cancer Trust embed unique units within hospitals across the UK, as well as funding specialist nurses to provide dedicated support for young people with cancer and their families. The money raised in Pippa's memory so far has given Teenage Cancer Trust the funds to buy a much-needed PBM machine - a desperately wanted machine at St James' hospital in Leeds which prevents nasty side effects of paediatric chemo. The money from this event will be used to fund many more living legacies in Pippa's name to help young people with cancer and their families.

School Disco Information

Saplings

Nursery and Reception Children.

Due to the age of the children school cannot supervise the children at the disco. Parents need to pick up their child from school at 3.30pm to get them changed and supervise them at the disco.

Years 1 - 3

If your child is booked into Saplings and wishes go to the disco then you need to book a Saplings place as normal and also purchase a disco ticket.

Children should bring their disco clothes to school in the morning. Saplings staff will help them get changed and take them to the school hall at 4.45pm.

You will then pick them up from the disco at 5.45pm.

Years 4 - 6

If your child is booked into Saplings we will take them to the disco at $6.00 \, \mathrm{pm}$.

Children should bring their disco clothes to school in the morning. Saplings staff will help them get changed and take them to the school hall.

You will then pick them up from the disco at 7.00pm

Pick Up and Drop off Information

Drop off and pick up - please enter through the main school entrance. Exit through the main playground to allow a one way system to operate.

Refreshments will be available in the library.
All nursery and reception children must be supervised by an adult
during the disco.
