Hot and Cold places

Here are some ideas if you wish to carry out a mini-project on an aspect of this...

- Research a place you would like to go on holiday - What is the weather like there and how would you get there?
• Watch the weather for the local area. Can you record how many times it rains in a week/month?
• Design and make a rain gauge to measure the rainfall.
• Research the animals that live in hot and cold places. What helps them live there? How do they survive in these environments?
• Look at the materials things in your house are made from. Can you list any of their properties? Why are these items made from that material?
