Spring 2: Learning opportunities: Celts and Romans

Here are a variety of OPTIONAL activities which you may wish to do with your child out of school to support and extend their learning in school.

This page is designed to help families to 'Enjoy Learning Together at Home'. However, if your child would like to share any of these tasks with us, we'd be delighted to see their work.

Spelling:

Practise the Year3/4 statutory word lists, using games we have learnt in school.



Maths:

Practise the times tables.
Children could hone their skills using Times Table Rockstars (make sure you're updated to the latest version).



Writing:

Imagine you have a magical timetravelling pen that can take you back to the time of the Celts and Romans. Write a short story to describe your adventure and what you discover.

Imagine meeting a friendly Celt and a kind Roman during your adventure. Describe what they are like. What do you talk about? Do they show you anything interesting or teach you something new?

Reading:

Encourage your child to read regularly at home. Support them with their reading by asking questions about what they have read. Encourage your child to read their library books at home too (and return them every Friday, so they can take out another book).



Science:

Draw and label a human skeleton
