The below information was sent out earlier this week regarding the Individual, sibling and class photos with Arts Photography on Tuesday 6th May

Arts Photography are a local, Leeds based, company who works with many schools in the Yorkshire area. They use a secure access portal for parent / carers use to view and order their children's photos / images.

Ashlands is required to seek parental consent to share the following information with Arts:

- Child's name / class
- Primary guardians email address.

The below link is to a Google Form for you to consent / decline for your child's photograph being taken and this information to be shared with Arts.

We are asking you to consent / decline to:

- Arts photography taking a picture of your child and their details (name / class) being shared with Arts
- Your email address being shared with Arts.

In the instance of a split family or if you want both parents to be able to view / order prints then both need to complete the form and consent to their email address being shared. The other parent will not be able to see this information.

Please note that you do need to actively consent or decline, and school cannot assume. In the event of no response, this must be taken as no consent.

If you consent, then Arts will communicate with you directly and photos will be sent direct to your home address. If you do not wish for your email address to be shared then then you will be given a paper proof and be able to contact Arts and manually place an order by phone with Arts.
