






Summer 1: Learning opportunities: The Tudors

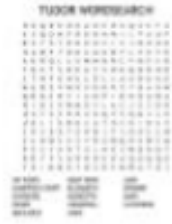
Some Tudor activities
