SUN CREAM

We would like to clarify our approach to sun cream, as we understand there may have been some confusion.

If needed, children may bring sun cream (named) into school and apply it themselves. We simply ask that it is kept safely in their bag and that children do not share it or apply it to others, as we need to be mindful of potential allergies.

Some families find that roll-on sun cream is a helpful option for children to use independently.

Although the weather has recently been less settled, when sunnier days return, please ensure your child:

- applies sun cream before school
- brings a named sun hat
- has a water bottle in school
